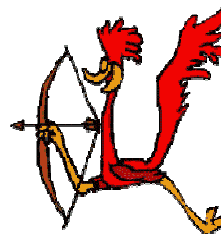

## **Private Lands Public Wildlife— Access Yes Program**

According to the Wyoming Game & Fish a \$1.00 donation to the Access Yes program will gain 4.2 acres of access. All donations go directly to landowner easements. During 2008, Access Yes donations provided access to over 1.6 million private acres for hunting and 93 streams miles, 129 pond acres and 157 lake acres for fishing.

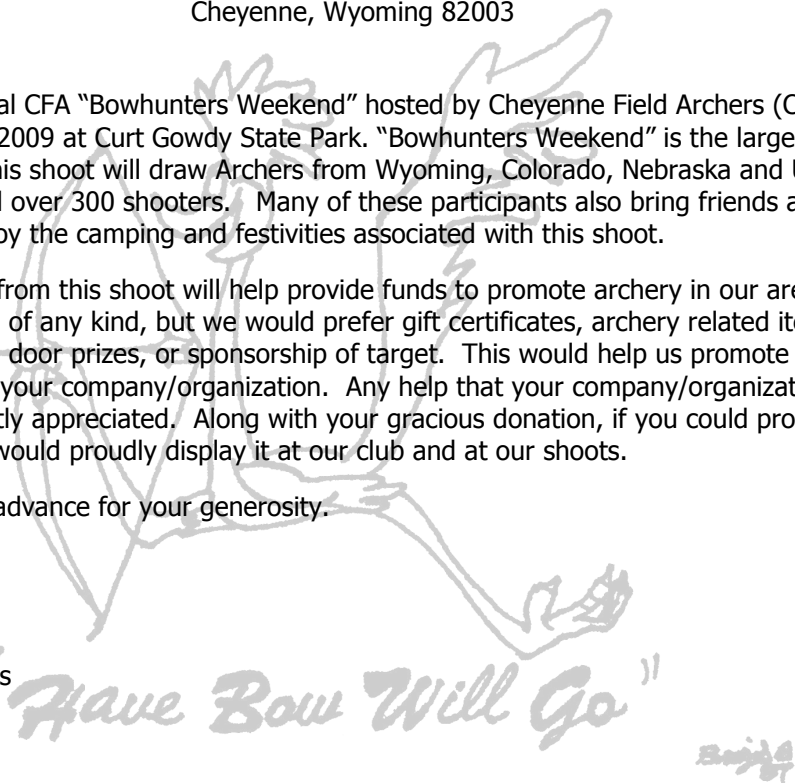

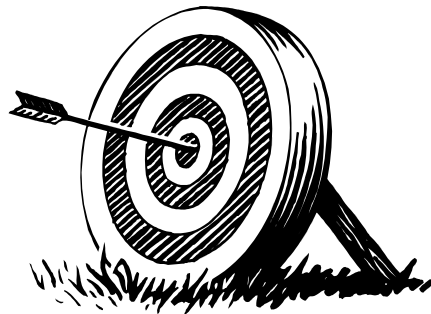
