Archery in the Schools

Ms. Tristanna Bickford and Mr. Jim Dawson from the Wyoming Game & Fish Department were present at the meeting. Ms. Bickford and Mr. Dawson gave us a presentation on the Archery Education Program. They shared a wealth of information about the program and answered our questions. It was agreed that we would like to assist with the Archery


