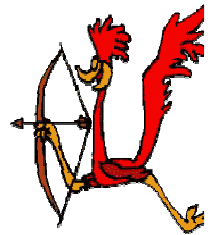
## **President's Corner**

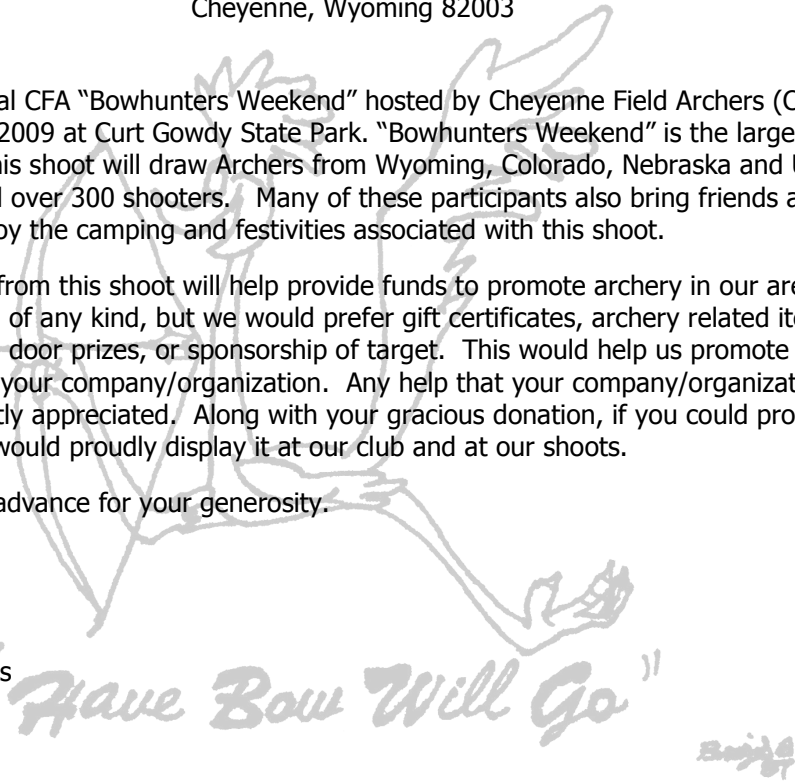
