Minutes of the Monthly Board Meeting

Dan Conrad proposed that we look at changing our rule at Bowhunter Weekend this year. The changes being considered are allowing moveable/slider sights for the Bowhunter Classes. Discussion will be held at the next few board meetings and a decision made prior to BHW.

A proposal was also made to add a Silver Senior Class. The board will take that into consideration as well.

Jim Mallon thanked the club for their donation to the auction for Bowhunters of Wyoming annual conference. They had a successful weekend.

We received a thank you from the CFA Scholarship Foundation for our donation for 2021.
