Minutes from 05/13/2019

Attendance: David Hays, Connie Crandall, Mike Lancaster, Robert Graham, Al Tharp, Greg Wooden, Neal Perkins, Jim Mallon, Kent Ketterling, Kelly Thornberry, Mat Rusk, Rob Sherman, David Contreras, Gary Cox.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President David Hays.

- We have 207 current members.
- Connie Crandall indicated that the treasurer's report was not available yet. Connie said she will be providing food and soda for the RMAA shoot Sunday, the 19th. Donations will be accepted for the club. As yet no food vendor is scheduled for BHW. Jim Mallon said a food truck had expressed interest and he will follow-up and let the board know.
- Connie said the Scholarship Dinner netted just under \$13,000.
- At this time CFA will not be providing archery for Super Day. David was told that non-profits will have to pay \$80 this year to participate. He had until close-of-business that day to respond; he polled as many of the board as possible, and the vote was no.
- David Contreras, Outdoor Adventure Rep., wanted to schedule their activity at the club. It was agreed upon Thu. & Fri. July 18th & 19th from 8 AM to Noon. There is no charge to the kids, who can be 8 to 15 years old. David was asked about the lady heading Super Day and her decision to charge non-profits. He said she was new and "ruffling a lot of feathers." The President and a couple board members plan to meet with the lady.
- Based on the experience cooking at the recent Trad Shoot, Greg Wooden and Connie expressed a need for a larger cooking surface/griddle. A motion was made and accepted to research this, provided the cost was \$300 or less.
- The Access Yes shoot of the Tue. & Thu. following the board meeting had "sprang upon us". Prizes and raffle items were quickly decided upon.
- After a discussion of the lack of help breaking down the two BHW courses in past years, a motion was made to have only have the one 'A' course this year. The motion passed. A motion was also made to not have a championship class this year. The motion passed – all Yeas, No Nays. Mike Lancaster passed out a revised set of BHW rules and class definitions. He wants attendees to proof-read them by the next board meeting.
- Kent Ketterling said JOAD ends this Saturday, the 18th. It will resume in late Oct. or early Nov.
- Neal said that a Kudo should go to Browen Anderson for the immaculate vacuuming, chair washing and cleaning of the board room.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:50 PM.

NO Alcoholic beverages may be carried or consumed on course, range or practice area during shooting hours.

NO CROSSBOWS OR RANGEFINDERS - RANDOM SPEED CHECK - 300 fps +3%

Use of vernier peeps will be allowed in all classes that allow sights.

Targets:

Max distance: 50 yards

1 arrow scoring: 12 - 10 - 8 - 5

40 unmarked targets each day with a shotgun start on Sunday.

All classes will shoot with their competition on Sunday.

Youth and Cubs will shoot all 40 targets Saturday for competition score. (Sunday shoot for fun only.)

FLIGHTING:

Saturday's score is used to determine which flight you shoot in on Sunday. All shooters in a particular flight start out even on Sunday. Sunday scores determine the overall winner each age group/class and flight.

(Cubs and Youth use Saturday scores only)

Adult classes will be awarded with a Gist silversmith belt buckle. Must have at least 2 shooters per class to qualify for buckle. Raffles on site, food is available on site. Novelty shoots Saturday afternoon, look for times.
